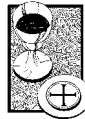

Today we celebrate the Dedication of Rome’s Basilica of St. John Lateran. It is the cathedral church of the Diocese of Rome (the Pope’s cathedral) and, as such, it is the mother church of every Catholic Church in the world, including our own.

Today’s feast is an invitation to consider again **what it means** to be part of this **‘ekklesia’** this church and parish of disciples of the Jesus who **“calls us out of”** ourselves, our own agendas, our own fears and heartaches to the ministries and vocations of spouses, parents, friends and neighbors. None of us will forget the enthusiasm and excitement when the Phillies won the World Series and over 2 million fans flooded Broad Street in a sea of **‘red and white’** to participate in the **‘Parade of Champions!’** **Just imagine how vibrant our Church, particularly our parish of St. Augustine would be, if we showed even 15%-25% of that energy and enthusiasm toward our faith and our parish! It would be overwhelming because we would be excited and enthused about being a disciple of Jesus Christ!** Let us pray that we can be enthusiastic and excited about our faith as Jesus **“calls us out of”** ourselves to proclaim the Gospel to all.

Today we welcome Michael Ruminiski who will speak to us about the annual appeal for St. Charles Borromeo Seminary. I ask you to pray for him and for all seminarians that they will continue to answer the call of Jesus to follow him.
